

BOILING AN EGG

After owning my Vacumatic cookware for 45 years, I just found out I could boil an egg without filling the pot with water.

1. Place your smallest pan on the burner.



2. Dampen a piece of paper towel.



3. Place the wet paper towel in the pan.



4. Place the egg on the wet paper towel.



5. Cover and put the heat on medium to medium-high.



6. When you hear the whistle from the whistle vent, close the vac-control valve and turn off the heat. Leave the pan on the burner.
7. Set timer for 5 minutes if you want soft boiled.



8. When timer goes off enjoy your egg.



I probably spent more money on electricity bringing a pot of water to a boil for my eggs over the last 45 years than what I originally spent on my whole set of this cookware. What a waist of time and money.
